The Government has said that we have to make sure that no-one is left out or treated unfairly just because they have a disability. The Government has said that this includes people you might not usually think of such as people with illnesses like cancer and multiple sclerosis. In fact, the government says that anyone who has a physical or mental difficulty which lasts for a year or more and which prevents them carrying out normal, everyday activities could be classed as disabled. People felt so strongly about this that, in 2005, the Disability Discrimination Act was passed. Part of this act says that places like school have to ask disabled people how we can make things better for them.
