Don't be late......lateness has a negative impact on learning!

Being late can disrupt lessons and affect achievement. It also means a loss of learning time:

5 minutes late every day adds up to 3 days lost each year

10 minutes adds up to 6 days lost each year

15 minutes adds up to 10 days lost each year 20 minutes adds up to 13 days lost each year

30 minutes adds up to 19 days lost each year

Please do everything possible to ensure that your child arrives at school on time every day. A free breakfast is provided from 7.50am daily for those children who arrive early.

All children should be in school by 8.20am.
